BINGO RULES

2. Cross off a square every time you complete a prompt. One book can count for more than one square!
3. Every time you complete a line (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal), bring your bingo sheet to any SPL library location to claim a raffle ticket. You can enter for one of the following prizes: 4 tickets to the Somerville Theatre, a \$50 gift card to Narrative Bookstore Gift Card, or a \$50 gift card to Michette Bakery.
4. If you cross off every square in your bingo sheet, congrats, you got BLACKOUT BINGO! Bring in your completed sheet to any SPL location and fill out ten raffle tickets for the prize of your choosing. **Bingo sheet must be returned by August 15.**
5. All raffle winners will be announced and notified the week of August 16.
